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### **NGSA Statement on Proposed EPA Methane Rule** *Industry Already Incentivized to Continue to Significantly Reduce Methane Emissions*

(Washington, D.C.) -- Dena E. Wiggins, president and CEO of the Natural Gas Supply Association, made the following statement about the Administration's new regulations on methane emissions:

“The industry’s existing record attests to the wholehearted commitment of natural gas producers to reducing methane emissions. We need time to review EPA’s new proposed rules on methane before commenting on the specifics, but in the meantime, we will point out that producers have already made deep cuts in methane emissions through voluntary measures and best practices. Well-functioning natural gas markets can help continue that trend going forward. Implementing new regulations on methane emissions fails to recognize the existing strong economic incentive to capture and utilize methane. We look forward to reviewing the details of the proposal.
