NGSA Chairman to Address 2009-2010 Winter Natural Gas Outlook on Oct. 14

(Washington, D.C.) The Natural Gas Supply Association's (NGSA) 9th Annual Winter Outlook media briefing will be held on Wednesday, October 14 at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. NGSA Chairman Pat Kuntz will discuss the upcoming winter natural gas market, looking at current and emerging trends in production, demand, storage, the economy, weather and what those may mean for consumers this winter.

NGSA analyzes five market factors annually that influence the natural gas market: the economy, weather, natural gas supply, natural gas demand and storage. For each of the five factors, NGSA will project which direction the public can expect pressure to be applied on the market this winter.
