NGSA Statement on Presidential Debate

(Washington, D.C.) -- Both President Obama and Governor Romney acknowledged the importance of natural gas in last night's presidential debate.

In a statement, Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA) president and CEO R. Skip Horvath said:
