### **NGSA Statement on Senate Committee Approval of Nominations of Norman Bay and Cheryl LaFleur to FERC**

(Washington, D.C.) – Dena E. Wiggins, president and CEO of the Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA), made the following statement today on the Senate Energy and Natural Resource Committee’s vote to approve the nomination of Norman Bay and the re-nomination of Cheryl LaFleur to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

“Our industry anticipates a decade of tremendous growth in natural gas supply and, as the regulator of the interstate pipeline grid, FERC plays a critical role in ensuring that this valuable resource reaches our customers. We look forward to working with both Ms. LaFleur and Mr. Bay once the full Senate has approved their nominations.
