### **NGSA Commends House Passage of LNG Export Legislation**

(Washington, DC) The Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA) today praised the House of Representatives for its bipartisan passage of H.R. 6, the “Domestic Prosperity and Global Freedom Act,” by a vote of 266 to 150. The legislation speeds up the process enabling the export of liquefied natural gas (LNG) to America’s allies.

Dena E. Wiggins, president and CEO of NGSA said:

“We commend the 266 members of Congress who voted in favor of H.R. 6. Streamlining the approval process for LNG export applications from the United States can create tens of thousands of American jobs and reduce global greenhouse gas emissions, while preserving a competitive advantage for American manufacturers. With the bill now headed to the Senate, we urge the Senate to vote in favor of legislation expediting the LNG export process.”
