Washington, D.C.: Following remarks by the President and Cabinet members at today’s “Unleashing American Energy” event at the Department of Energy, the [Natural Gas Supply Association](http://www.ngsa.org) and [Center for Liquefied Natural Gas](http://www.clng.org) issued the following statements:
