NGSA Congratulates House, Urges Senate to Continue Permitting Reform Momentum

(Washington, D.C.) – The Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA) released the following statement to show its support of the House's efforts to move forward with meaningful permitting reform legislation, like H.R. 3898: PERMIT Act, H.R. 3668: Improving Interagency Coordination for Pipeline Review Act and H.R. 4776, Standardizing Permitting and Expediting Economic Development (SPEED) Act.
