Patricia W. Jagtiani is Executive Vice President of the Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA).

As executive vice president, Pat assists in strategic planning and policy development for the association in addition to representing NGSA before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and numerous other government entities. In this capacity, she works closely with NGSA's membership to develop consensus on key issues pertaining to regulatory and climate policies that impact natural gas producers and marketers. Most recently, Pat has played a lead role in industry discussions with other natural gas and power industry stakeholders regarding fuel assurance and

natural gas reliability.

Prior to joining NGSA, Pat served as an advisor on natural gas and oil pipeline matters for then-FERC Chairman Hoecker and played a leadership role in the policy development of Order No. 637, which led to significant pipeline structural and pricing improvements aimed at increasing competition in the natural gas industry. During her earlier years at the Commission, Pat served as an expert witness testifying in numerous pipeline rate proceedings.
